A **Winemakers 101** course for beginning winemakers will be offered each Tuesday from 6:30pm to 8:00pm in the lower church hall of Casa Italiana/Holy Rosary Church located at 595 Third Street, NW beginning Tuesday, May 5th. William Meaux and Romeo Sabatini will be teaching the course, using the text by Daniel Pambianchi "*Techniques in Home Winemaking*", which if desired, can be ordered for you, together with a hydrometer to measure sugar content. Please circle appropriate items in order form below. The course will cover everything a beginner needs to know, but will also be a good refresher for winemakers who still consider this a new hobby and may wish to learn more about the technical nature of the winemaking process.

NEW : The course will also include one session covering beer brewing techniques, taught by John Paul Maye, Ph.D.

The course is \$99 for all 6 weeks, and at the last session the students are invited to visit Mr Sabatini's Beltsville home vineyard to review picking of the grapes (when in season), measurements of grape sugar and acid contents, and the crushing and pressing process.
