Juice may be crushed from fresh grapes and carried away in food grade 6 gallon pails with lids, if purchased above. The club is purchasing a crusher-destemmer for use by members, and a shared cost of \$3 per box is required. Members may crush their own grapes and carry away all juice and stems. PROCESSED JUICE WILL ALSO BE SOLD in 6 GALLON PAILS.

**Dear Winemakers:**

**Premium California grapes are coming into maturity a bit later this year, and we have scheduled Saturday, October 16, 2010 as the target distribution date for arrival of our grape shipment from California this year. Michael Colavita, our provider in California, has assured me of excellent quality grapes and juice.**

**On the opposite side of this page, please find the grape order form. To order, fill it out and send it to the address on the form with your check or money order no later than 30 September 2010. .**

**We have reinstated the purchase of juice by popular demand. The winemakers association met on July 25, 2010 at Holy Rosary Church and voted unanimously to reinstate the purchase of juice.**

**Last year, the Washington Winemakers purchased a crusher-destemmer for use by our members. As you see at the bottom of the order form, you will share a small charge per box of grapes ordered to use the crusher-destemmer (to help cover its cost) at Villa Rosa and you may order 6 gallon pails with lids to carry your juice home. There is no way to get fresher juice than this. We will continue to offer this service to our members. Any member may chose this option to use the group's crusher and will be responsible for crushing their own grapes and carrying away all juice and by products of crushing so that no waste is left at Villa Rosa. Members will be in queue for crushing at Villa Rosa based on the order in which their grape order form with check is received.**
